NOTICE FOR AD-HOC PANEL 2022-23

Applications from suitable candidates for being empaneled for appointment as ad-hoc Lecturer/Assistant Professor (Academic Year 2022-23) in Statistics in the colleges/Department of the University of Delhi are hereby invited by **Thursday, 09th June, 2022 upto 4.30 P.M.** As part of the bio-data to be submitted along with the application form, the candidates should specify the category (Gen/SC/ST/OBC/PH) to which they belong. The applications along with the bio-data may be submitted in the office of the Department by the date stipulated above. Self-attested Copies of all certificates, marks sheets, etc. should also be enclosed with the application. The application form is available at the Department website:- <http://statistics.du.ac.in>

NOTE: The application may be submitted by hand or by registered post and must reach in the office of the Department of Statistics at the above mentioned address. Any application received after the closing date and time shall not be accepted. The Department shall not be responsible for any postal delay.

- The minimum essential qualification for being enrolled in the ad-hoc Panel 2022-23 for appointment as Ad-hoc Assistant Professor will be at least Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in the subject of statistics from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the CSIR (exemptions from NET and having acquired Ph.D. shall be granted in accordance with UGC Regulations).
- A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC)/Scheduled Tribe (ST)/Other Backward Classes (OBC) (non-creamy layer)/Differently Abled [Persons with Benchmark Disability PWD]] in accordance with UGC Regulations. The relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
