CV BUILDING WORKSHOP AND CV VETTING

The Alumni Connect Cell, Department of Statistics, organized a CV & Aptitude Workshop as part of its placement preparation initiatives. The session was conducted by Mr. Piyush Kedia, Qualified Actuary and Senior Consultant at EY LLP, who shared industry-relevant insights and practical career guidance with students.

The session began with an overview of evolving recruiter expectations in leading organizations. Emphasis was placed on crafting resumes that effectively highlight strengths, problem-solving abilities, and career objectives, rather than merely listing achievements. The importance of tailoring CVs to specific roles, internships, and company requirements was also highlighted.

Common mistakes in resume preparation, including irrelevant content, unprofessional formatting, lack of quantifiable achievements, and weak language structure, were discussed. To enhance practical learning, individual resume reviews were conducted, with personalized feedback on alignment, spacing, clarity of content, sentence construction, and overall presentation, enabling students to refine their resumes in real time.

The latter part of the workshop focused on aptitude preparation, highlighting the role of aptitude tests in recruitment and competitive examinations. Key areas such as quantitative aptitude, logical reasoning, and data interpretation were covered, along with strategies to improve speed, accuracy, time management, and logical thinking. Guidance was also provided on maintaining composure during tests and interviews.

The workshop was highly interactive, with active student participation and discussions on resume building, interview preparation, internships, and career planning. Queries were addressed with practical insights, contributing significantly to students' confidence and readiness for future recruitment processes.
