**Report on Anti-Ragging Measures at Department of Statistics on Anti-Ragging Day, August 12, 2024**

University of Delhi (DU) is committed to ensuring a safe and welcoming environment for all students. Ragging, a menace in many educational institutions, is strictly prohibited at DU. This report highlights various initiatives undertaken by DU towards maintaining a Ragging free campus.

Department of Statistics, Faculty of Mathematical Sciences, University of Delhi is delighted to offer the Anti-Ragging report on behalf of the Anti-Ragging Committee. We are happy to notify all that anti-ragging measures are always strictly followed at department of Statistics with objective to prevent ragging and to promoting the welfare of students. The awareness about anti-ragging was further well displayed by arranging one day Induction program.

Students Induction program conducted on August 12, 2024

The Induction program was organized on 12 August 2024 for newly admitted post graduate students of the academic year 2024-25 in the presence of two invited speakers respectively from IIT Delhi and Institute and Academy of Actuary Science at Department of Statistics. This program was designed to educate students about the ill effects of ragging and the consequences of engaging in such activities. Students were made aware of the legal provisions and penalties associated with ragging. The response from the students was highly positive, and they actively participated in these programs. A UGC prepared video on motivation aimed at realising its adverse effects was shown to the gathering of students.

The Anti-Ragging Departmental Committee was formed well in advance. As per UGC instruction, from this year Anti-Ragging Day would be observed on 12<sup>th</sup> August followed by Anti-Ragging Week from 12<sup>th</sup> August to 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2024.
