The team efficiently handled every aspect of the drive, from registration to post-donation care, making the initiative a well-organized and impactful effort.

Impact

From the total of 110 participants, 73 units of blood were collected from eligible donors, contributing to the supply needed in hospitals and healthcare facilities. The blood donation drive was a remarkable success, with the collective efforts of organizers and participants playing a vital role in addressing the crucial demand for blood in medical care.
